



## **VOICE Programme**Victims of Coercive Intimate Experience

A 10-week psycho-educational programme for victims and survivors of domestic abuse, coercive control and behaviours that create the dynamic of intimate partner relationship abuse.

## The programme aims to:

- Address the various behaviours of a controlling partner, both before separation and post-separation
- Highlight how digital technology can be used as a tool to perpetrate domestic abuse and coercive control
- Offer psychoeducation on trauma, and the significant impact of such traumatic experiences
- Equip victims and survivors with self-regulation and self-care tools

Using a variety of different learning styles and media, this programme can be delivered in person, online or in a 1:1 or group capacity.
